

Spectacles

Criteria	Good Example

Shoes

Criteria	Good examples
<p>Shoes are to be black or white, the material made from rubber or canvas, and must have either laces or velcro lace-ups. Loafers are strictly not allowed.</p> <p>i.e. Black shoes with laces</p>	
<p>Black shoes with velcro lace ups</p>

Boys' Hair

Criteria	Good example(s)
Front (Hair at the front does not touch eyebrows)	
Side (Sideburns do not exceed over half of the ear)	
Back (Hair at the back does not touch the collar)

Girls' Attire

Criteria	Good example(s)
<p>Correct attire entails:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Ties (on Mondays and during special events)2. Collars buttoned up (on Mondays and during special events)3. WMSKL socks4. Criteria	Good Example
<p>Bangs (Bangs should not cover the face. Bangs and any stray hairs should be clipped to the sides.)</p>	
<p>Short hair (hair at the back does not touch the collar)</p>

Girls' earrings

Criteria	Good Example	Bad Example
<p>Earrings</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">-Size: should not exceed 5mm in diameter)-Colour (only plain gold, silver, black, white colors are permitted)-Hoop earrings are also not permitted.-Earrings are only to be worn on the earlobe.-Multiple piercings are not allowed.
